

WILLIAM KARROW PASSES AWAY

**Island Pioneer Died Early Today at
Appleton Hospital at the
Age of 68 Years**

An illness of long standing at 4:45 o'clock this morning resulted in the death of William Karrow, 379 Naymut street, at St. Elizabeth hospital in Appleton.
