Henry Williams, Papermill Employe, Struck By Street Car

Henry Williams, 39, whose wife and six children live at 638 Telulah-st, died Thursday morning in a hospital in Niagara Falls, N. Y., of injuries received about a week ago when he was struck by a street car. Williams, who had been in the east for only a few months, was employed by the Kimberly-Clark Co., but was not on duty when he was injured.

The body will be brought here for burial but the time of the funeral has not been set. It is said his wife is quite seriously ill here. His survivors include the widow, three sons and three daughters.
