

Joseph Cyr, Sawyer For Oconto-Co., Dies

OCONTO, Wis.—Joseph Cyr, 51, died at his home on McDonald street here Sunday morning of complications. He had been ill for 14 months. The body was taken to the Gagnon Funeral home and the funeral will be held Wednesday morning with services at 9 o'clock at St. Peter's Catholic church, the Rev. Byron Belongia officiating. Interment will be in the Oconto Catholic cemetery.

Cyr was born at Oconto Aug.

11, 1889 and lived here all his life. He was head sawyer for the Oconto company here, by whom he was employed for 36 years.

On June 11, 1912 he married Emma Wachal, who survives him as do two sons, Franklin and Raymond, Oconto; two sisters, Mary Auger, Oconto, and Rose Smith, Menasha; also a brother, Henry Cyr, Green Bay, and two grandchildren.
