

AGED RESIDENT DIES

Gustave August Maasz is Victim of Linger- ing Illness—Funeral to Be Held Thursday.

Gustave August Maasz, who had been a resident of Winnebago county for 64 years, passed away this morning at 10:10 o'clock after a lingering illness. The deceased was born Aug. 28, 1861 in the town of Black Wolf. On Jan. 27, 1910 he married Mrs. Anna Lueders. The event took place in this city. Although Mr. Maasz had been a farmer practically all his life, the last thirteen years of his life had been spent in Oshkosh. The survivors are his wife, three sisters, Mrs. Elizabeth Heller of Eldorado, Mrs. Charles Heller and Mrs. Jacob Wickert, both of this city; one brother, Edward Maasz of Fond du Lac, and several nieces and nephews.
