

MRS. ABEL CYR DIES AT RESIDENCE ON SATURDAY

OCONTO, Wis.—Mrs. Abel Cyr, 78, for more than a half century a resident of Oconto, died at her home Saturday afternoon of a heart ailment. The body was removed to the Gagnon funeral home, and services will be held Tuesday morning at St. Peter's Catholic church, the Rev. J. J. Looze officiating. Interment will be in the Oconto Catholic cemetery.

Mrs. Cyr was born at L'Anse au Gascon, Province of Quebec, Canada, Sept. 25, 1860, and came to Oconto in 1887 residing here since. Her husband preceded her in death two years ago. The survivors including four children, Joseph Cyr and Mrs. M. Auger, Oconto, Henry Cyr, Green Bay, Mrs. Donald Smith, Neenah; 13 grandchildren and six great grandchildren; also three sisters and one brother in Canada. She was a member of the Royal Neighbors of America and of the St. Anne society of St. Peter's church.
