

A. Kuchenbecker Dies at Age 89

Albert Frederick Kuchenbecker, 89, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Bernard J. Kloss, 101 Dennhardt ave., Neenah, at 11:30 p. m. Thursday after a lengthy illness.
