

John Leininger, Sr., 86, Is Victim of Pneumonia

Seymour—John Leininger, Sr., 86, died at 9:50 Wednesday morning at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Joseph Huettl, Seymour, after a brief illness with pneumonia.

He was born Dec. 25, 1851, at Germantown, Wis. On Nov. 11, 1879, he married Miss Annie Williams and settled on a farm in the town of Osborn. Seventeen years ago he came to Seymour to live. His wife died four years ago.
