

MRS. CHARLES LUEBKE DIES

Mrs. Charles F. Luebke, 82, died at 2:50 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Martin Gmeiner, 681 Oak street, following an illness of more than a year's duration.

Born in Germany on May 16, 1860, Mrs. Luebke came to the United States and directly to Caledonia at the age of 11. She was married on Nov. 1, 1877, and moved to Neenah about 30 years ago, residing with her daughter the past four years. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran church and the Ladies' Aid society of the church.

Surviving are six daughters, Mrs. William Westfahl, Oshkosh; Mrs. Martin Gmeiner, Mrs. Martin Wachholz, Mrs. Ernest Kramer, and Mrs. Charles Kuchenbecker, all of Neenah, and Mrs. John Manteufel, Clayton; three sons, Otto Luebke, Neenah; Carl W. Luebke, West Allis, and Oscar A. Luebke, Clayton. A daughter, Mrs. Esther Kramer, died four years ago and her husband passed away Mar. 18, 1930.
