

AGED NEENAH WOMAN DIED SUNDAY MORNING

Forty-One Grand Children and Seventy-Five Great Grandchildren
Survive

Mrs. Karl Fromming, aged ninety-three years, died Sunday morning at 1 o'clock at the home of her son, Charles Luebke, 118 Third avenue.

Mrs. Fromming was born in Germany, May 10, 1826 and came to this country in 1873. She has made her home with her son for the past nineteen years, ever since the death of her husband, Karl Fromming.

The deceased is survived by four sons, Fred, of Mayville, Wis.; Charles, of this city; Ferdinand, of Iron Ridge and William, of Milwaukee; one daughter, Mrs. Sharp.
