

Long Time Neenah Road Chief Dies

NEENAH — Martin R. Wachholz, 84, 138 Meade St., Neenah street commissioner from 1921 until his retirement in 1946, died at 5:20 a.m. today after an illness of several months.

He was born Nov. 12, 1882 in Menasha and was a life resident of the Twin Cities. He formerly operated a transfer business in Neenah and was a former employe of Hardwood Products Corp. Mr. and Mrs. Wachholz celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in 1959.

Survivors include the widow, one daughter and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Monday at Trinity Lutheran Church with the Rev. G. A. Schaefer officiating. Burial will be in Oak Hill Cemetery.
