

Ole Borgen

Following an illness of six weeks, Ole Borgen, a lifelong resident of the town of Amherst, died Monday morning at 4 o'clock at St. Elizabeth's hospital at Appleton.

Mr. Borgen was born in Amherst on January 8, 1876, a son of Thorbjorn and Anna Borgen. His marriage to Paulina Hartman took place in 1889. Mrs. Borgen died on May 22, 1934.

Mr. Borgen had served as an officer of the Amherst bank and also of the Amherst Telephone company at various times.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Amund Toftum, and a son, Leslie Borgen, both of Amherst; a brother, George Borgen, and two sisters, Mrs. Tom Pale and Mrs. Ella Sannes. A daughter, Effie Borgen, died on May 25, 1918, and a son, Raymond, passed away on November 13, 1918.

Funeral services were held this afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Borgen home and at 2:30 o'clock at the church. Rev. H. M. Blegen officiated and burial took place in the Greenwood cemetery at Amherst.
