

WIDOW OF MAN GONE FOR 7 YEARS GIVEN INSURANCE PREMIUMS

Mrs. Iva Van Ryzin, widow of Oscar J. Van Ryzin and administratrix of his estate, was awarded \$416.90 by Judge Fred V. Heine-mann, sitting in the upper branch of municipal court Monday. The defendant in the case was the Prudential Life Insurance company and the money represented premiums paid on a life insurance policy held by her husband.

Oscar J. Van Ryzin disappeared in April 1919 and as nothing has been heard from him and a seven year period has elapsed, he is declared legally dead. His estate is being closed in county court.
