

GILBERT NEFF, EX-ALDERMAN, PASSES AWAY

Gilbert Neff Sr., 72 years of age, former member of the common council, died suddenly at about 10 o'clock this morning of a heart attack at his home, 215 East Franklin avenue. He had suffered from a heart malady for the past two years.

Mr. Neff, the son of Samuel Neff, one of the oldest settlers in this locality, was born on a farm in West Menasha near the site of the present Lakeview paper mill. He served for several years as city street commissioner and was alderman from the First ward from 1904 to 1906 and from 1910 to 1914. He was in charge of the development and improvement of Oak Hill cemetery a few years ago. He was married to Carrie Smith of Clayton on December 12, 1888.

Surviving are the widow and two children, Gilbert Neff Jr. and Mrs. Cassie Renner; four grandchildren and two brothers, Myron Neff of Spokane, Wash., and John Neff of Withee.

Mr. Neff was a member of the First Presbyterian church and of the Modern Woodmen.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home and at 2 o'clock at the Presbyterian church, Rev. Walter R. Courtenay and Rev. D. C. Jones conducting. Burial will be in Oak Hill cemetery.
