## JOHN M. SPOO IS DEAD.

Well-Known Clothing Merchant Expires Suddenly This Morning at an Early Hour, Heart Failure Being the Cause-He Came Here Thirty Years Ago-He and His Son Associated in Business.

John M. Spoo, senior member of the clothing firm of Spoo & Son, died suddenly of heart failure at his home, 41 East Lincoln avenue, this morning, shortly after midgight. He had been

He had been about his business yesterday, and last evening visited with his mother in this city, and on arriving at his home appeared to feel as well as usual. At 11:30 o'clock, however, he became ill, and passed away an hour later. He had been troubled with a weak heart and asthma for some time.

The deceased was born in Germany October 23, 1850. He came to Oshkosh thirty years ago from Saarbrucken, near the Rhine, and was a salesman at the Bernstein clothing store for some time. Later he was in the clothing department of S. Heymann & Co. Nineteen years ago Mr. Spoo became identified with the Continental clothing house, and was manager of that store for a long time.

Two years ago, Mr. Spoo and his son, Erwin, decided to go into business for themselves, and established the store of Spoo & Son at 121 Main street.
