

Ida Van Ryzin Dies at Home

Rites Thursday for Stratford Woman, 82

Stratford — Mrs. Ida Van Ryzin, 82, a resident of Stratford since 1916, died at her home here last night about 8:30 o'clock. She had been ill for several months.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon at the First Presbyterian Church with the Rev. William C. Knobloch officiating. The body will repose at the Sauter Funeral Home from Wednesday morning until 11 a. m. Thursday, when it will be taken to the church.

Mrs. Van Ryzin, nee Minor, was born Jan. 14, 1869, in Neillsville. She received her education and married Albert Van Ryzin in that city on April 7, 1886.

Following her marriage she lived in Marshfield until 1890 and then moved to Auburndale, where she resided until 1916. Since that time she has lived in Stratford. Her husband preceded her in death in June, 1917.

Survivors include two sons, Walter, Town of Cleveland; and William, Stratford; three grandchildren, and one sister, Mrs. George Theobald.

Mrs. Van Ryzin was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.
