

SLIPS BOARDING FALLS CAR AND LOSES HIS LEG

Henry Williams, of Wisconsin,
Had Been Visiting Here.

Henry Williams, 37 years old, Appleton, Wis., employed by a construction company at Niagara Falls, slipped when trying to board a high speed car at Tonawanda today and fell under the wheels. His right leg was so badly crushed it was amputated at De Graff hospital.

Williams was returning from a visit to Mr. and Mrs. Christ Fielder, 138 Roesch avenue, Buffalo, and was changing from the old Falls line to the high speed car at Tonawanda.

Jacob Pynyoski, 45 years old, who lives in a laborers' camp in the Military road beyond the city line, suffered an injured leg when he jumped from a moving trolley near the camp last night. He is in the Lafayette General hospital.

John Disler, 50 years old, 720 Broadway, who was hit by a street car while crossing Genesee street at Sprenger avenue, is in a serious condition at the Memorial hospital. He may have a fractured skull.
