

DEATH CLAIMS WM. STURGIS

William A. Sturgis, 63, resident of the town of Neenah and vicinity for 57 years, died at 8 o'clock this morning at his home in the town of Neenah. Survivors are the wife and three sons, Orlie of Port Washington, Jay and Harrison of Neenah; one brother, Frank Sturgis, Chicago; one sister, Mrs. S. Hanselman of Kenosha; and six grandchildren.

Born in Livingston county, New York, July 6, 1867, Mr. Sturgis was brought to Wisconsin by his parents when a child of six. Thef amily made their home on a farm in the town of Neenah. He was married to Jessie Smith on March 15, 1893. From 1905 to 1907 Mr. and Mrs. Sturgis resided at Rib Lake but returned to the farm in the town of Neenah where they had resided since. He was injured in an accident in 1914 and never fully recovered.

Mr. Sturgis was a member of the First Methodist Episcopal church here and was a charter member of the E. F. U.

The funeral will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Methodist church, the service to be conducted by Rev. T. J. Reykdal. Burial will be in the family lot in Oak Hill cemetery.
