

Recover Body Of Fisherman Gone 10 Days

NEENAH — The body of Otto F. Luebke, 73, of 126 W. Columbian Ave., who was missing for 10 days after he failed to return from fishing, was recovered Saturday afternoon from Little Lake Butte des Morts.

Dale Londo, Rt. 2, Menasha, a fisherman, sighted the body at 2:10 p.m., floating in the water about 1,500 feet off shore from the end of High Street. Recovery of the body ended a search which had gone on since Thursday, Oct. 14.

He was reported missing Wednesday, Oct. 13, after he failed to return home from fishing below the Neenah dam.

The bodies of two other men, missing and presumed drowned, still have not been recovered, Sheriff Victor Jordan reported today. He said searchers have given up dragging operations for Claude Werner, Rt. 2, Appleton, and Roger Bushman, 27, of Manitowoc.

Fell From Barge

Bushman fell into Lake Winnebago Oct. 17 from a tug towing a barge to Oshkosh from Green Bay. Werner has not been seen since he rented a boat to go fishing in Little Lake Butte des Morts Oct. 19. The overturned boat was found the next day.



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
