

REINHOLD KRAMER DIES AT AGE OF 83; WAS BORN IN GERMANY

Reinhold Kramer, 83, of 268 School street, passed away at his home last evening at 7:45 o'clock. His health had been failing for some time.

Born in Germany Sept. 24, 1863, he came to Neenah at the age of 17, and later moved to Oshkosh residing here since. He was married to Emilie Hansen in Oshkosh Aug. 31, 1890. He was a charter member of St. John's English Lutheran church.

Survivors are his wife; two daughters, Mrs. Herman Oberg, of Oshkosh, and Mrs. Arthur De-Cramer, of Eldorado; and one son, Reginald Kramer, Oshkosh. One son, Christel, preceded him in death 17 years ago. Also surviving are 10 grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Funeral services will be held Saturday at 2:00 o'clock at St. John's English Lutheran church, the Rev. E. R. Wicklund officiating. Interment will be in Riverside cemetery. Friends may call at the Fiss & Bills funeral home Thursday evening and Friday after 3:30 until 11 o'clock Saturday morning, when the remains will be taken to the church to lie in state until the hour of the service.
